

THE heat FUND

The Home Energy Assistance Top-Up (HEAT) Fund supports Nova Scotians in need with the added cost of home heating during the winter months. In 2020, the Fund provided assistance for more than 3,500 households in Nova Scotia. The Fund is proudly administered by The Salvation Army.

You may apply if:

- You live in Nova Scotia and are within the following income threshold:
 - o \$29,000 for one-person households;
 - o \$47,703 for two to four person households;
 - o \$67,937 for households with five or more individuals
- Your household is experiencing an emergency heating situation

The HEAT Fund offers a maximum assistance in the amount of \$400 for individuals and families.
