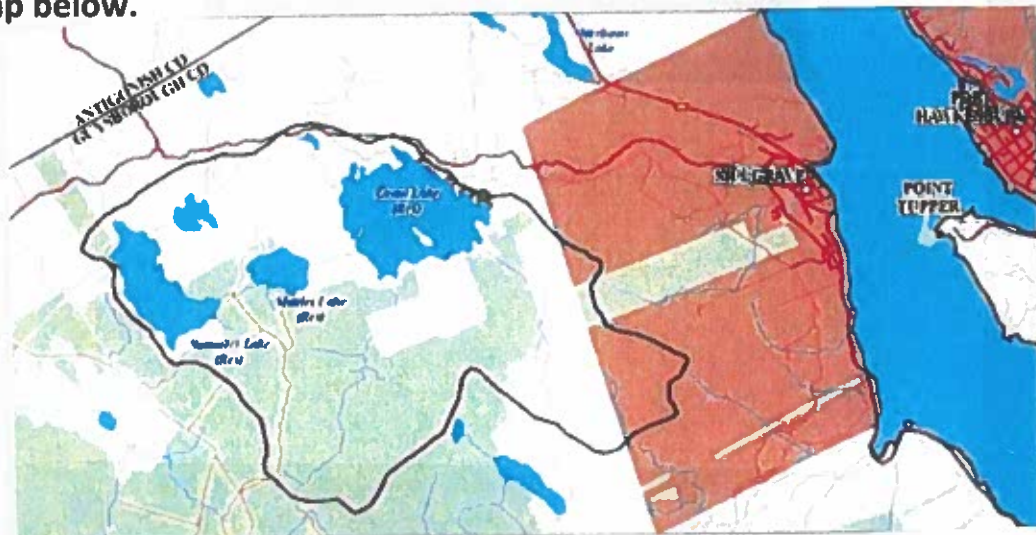
SOURCE WATER PROTECTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Town of Mulgrave, under an operating permit provided to the water utility by the Department of Environment and Climate Change, is required to develop and maintain a Source Water Protection Plan (SWPP). The intent of a SWPP is to keep clean water clean, thereby providing a safe source of water supply for treatment and distribution. The Town of Mulgrave, in the development and maintenance of the SWPP, has created an Advisory Committee.

The Town of Mulgrave is seeking members for its Source Water Protection Advisory Committee:

At least one (1) resident of the Town of Mulgrave, and

At least one (1) landowner within the Grant Lake Watershed Area, as indicated in the map below.



The Committee will meet as necessary, but no less than twice in each calendar year. All meetings are open to the public and are held in Council Chambers, with participation via Zoom available.
